

2011 - Spectator Viewing Information

The **RACE SITE** is an excellent place to view the race! Besides the exciting start and finish, the participants will come back by the race site along 56th Street at 4.5 miles! If you are watching the Full Marathon, you can walk 4 blocks North on Post Road to 59th Street and watch your runner go into the State Park at 12.5 miles. The next place to go is down 56th Street (3.5 miles) to Fall Creek Parkway. The participants run under 56th Street on the bike path and pass this park-like area twice - outbound near mile 17, then back at mile 21! We offer a **FREE SHUTTLE** to this location!

NEW in 2011 – Marathon Cheer Zone !!

We will be running a free shuttle bus from the Race Site to 56th and Fall Creek Parkway to take you out to cheer on your runner! The shuttle will make continuous round trips from 10:00am-1:30pm to the Marathon Cheer Zone. This is the part of the race where the going gets tough, so cheer them on twice - at miles 17 & 21, and then we'll get you back to the Race Site in time to see them cross the finish line! Treat yourself as well! We will have music playing and there is a Starbucks, CVS, Walgreens, Hardees, and Burger King all within walking distance of the Cheer Zone.
